Honorary Consuls may fly the national flag of sending State on their means of transport only when these are used on official business and with due regard to the laws, regulations and usages of the receiving State. The national flag of the sending State and its coat-of-arms may be displayed on the building occupied by the consular post and at the entrance door thereof and on the residence of the Honorary Consul.
